

Year 12 Curriculum Provision

French or Spanish Language (Exam board used: AQA)

English Literature (Currently Edexcel)

Currently:

40% coursework- *Macbeth* and *Othello* essay plus a creative piece

60% exam. - Novels: *The Magic Toyshop*- Angela Carter, *Jane Eyre*- Charlotte Bronte

This will change and will be mainly exam based at A/S.

English GCSE

Currently any student entering 6th form must take this course if they have not achieved a C or above. Attendance is mandatory. There are timetabled lessons and exam period is January or Summer series.

Maths

Students are taught in ability set classes and follow the OCR Maths specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons per week.

History

At AS History students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the Edexcel specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons per week.

Geography

At AS Geography students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the Edexcel specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons per week.

Philosophy

In AS Philosophy students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the AQA specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons per week.

Sociology

In AS Sociology students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the AQA specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons per week.

Biology

From September 2015 students will study Biology in line with the Ofqual subject content and experimental techniques following course specifications. Students are taught in mixed ability groups but need to meet GCSE pre-requisites to enter the course.

Physics

From September 2015 students will study Physics in line with the Ofqual subject content and experimental techniques following course specifications. Students are taught in mixed ability groups but need to meet GCSE pre-requisites to enter the course.



Chemistry

From September 2015 students will study Chemistry in line with the Ofqual subject content and experimental techniques following course specifications. Students are taught in mixed ability groups but need to meet GCSE pre-requisites to enter the course.

Psychology

From September 2015 students will study Psychology in line with the Ofqual subject content and experimental techniques following course specifications.

Information Technology

Students will study the Edexcel Applied ICT course in line with Ofqual subject content. The course consists of two coursework units and one exam based unit.

Applied Science BTEC Subsidiary Diploma

This course covers all three sciences and is delivered in accordance to Edexcel guidance. Students study 60 credits which is equivalent to an A2 level. This is taught over two years.

PE

In AS Physical Education students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the Edexcel specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons per week and cover unit 1 and unit 2.

Drama and Theatre Studies

In AS Drama and Theatre Studies students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the Edexcel specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons a week.

Media Studies

In AS Media Studies students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the AQA specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons a week.

Art and Design

In AS Art and Design students are taught in mixed ability classes and follow the WJEC specification. They will be taught for 5 lessons a week.

BTEC Extended Diploma in Sport

This course is delivered in accordance to Edexcel guidance. Students study 19 units and are taught over two years.

Enrichment

Students engage in a variety of predominantly academic, sporting and cultural activities. These include Museum learning, additional languages, organic gardening and the Duke of Edinburgh Award. Enrichment is targeted at students and is optional in years 9 to 13. Students attend targeted activities when required but can also join or support a preferred activity as well as suggest new ones.
