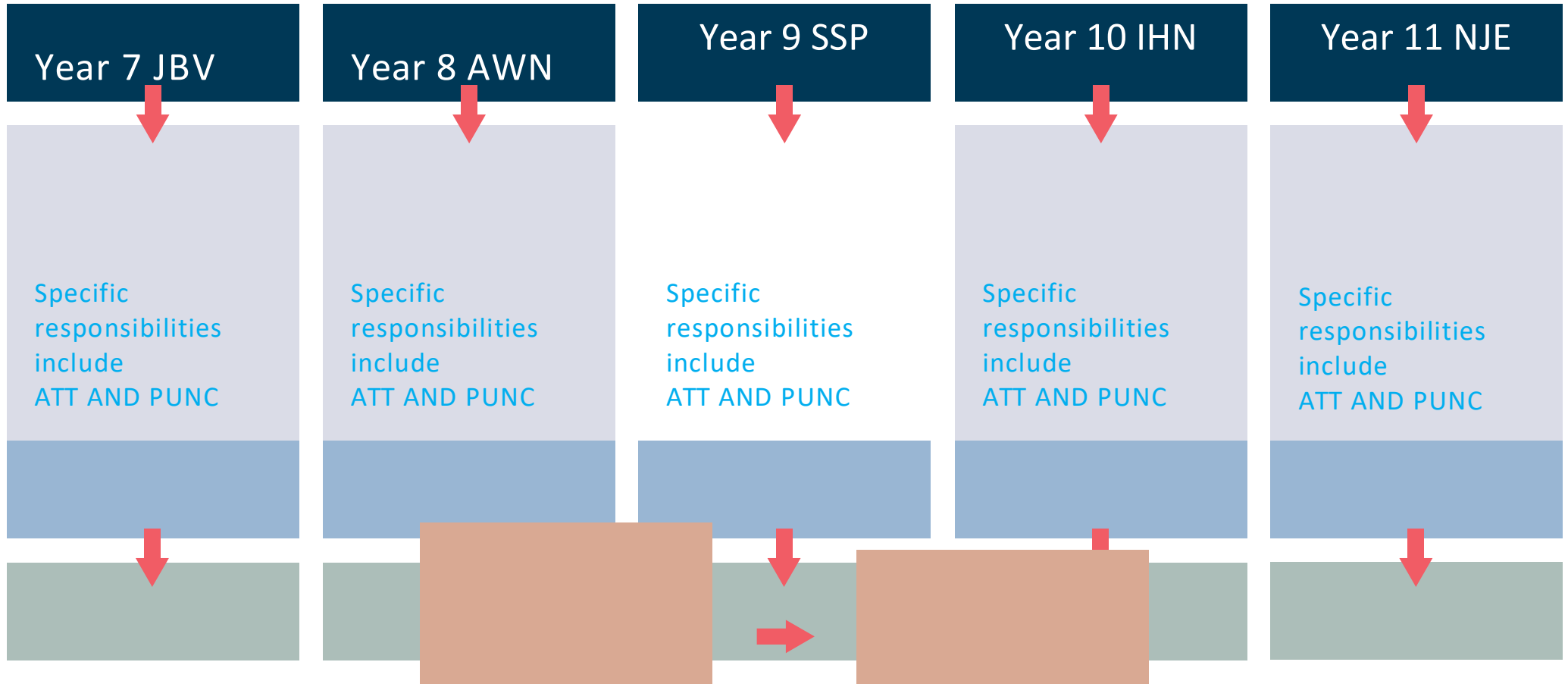

ASSISTANT TO RSL
