The Langley Academy is encouraging our adult community to take part in this Reading Challenge - you are invited to pick six reads and record your reading in a diary provided by The Reading Agency to get a certificate.

The scheme was launched nationally in 2008 by The Reading Agency and it is now run at local level through public libraries, adult education, colleges, prisons and workplaces. In 2012, 23,500 people across the UK registered to take part - 30% up on 2011 and 90% of survey respondents said that they were more confident about reading after taking part in the Six Book Challenge.

The annual Six Book Challenge invites people to pick six reads (not just books but poetry, magazines, newspapers etc).
